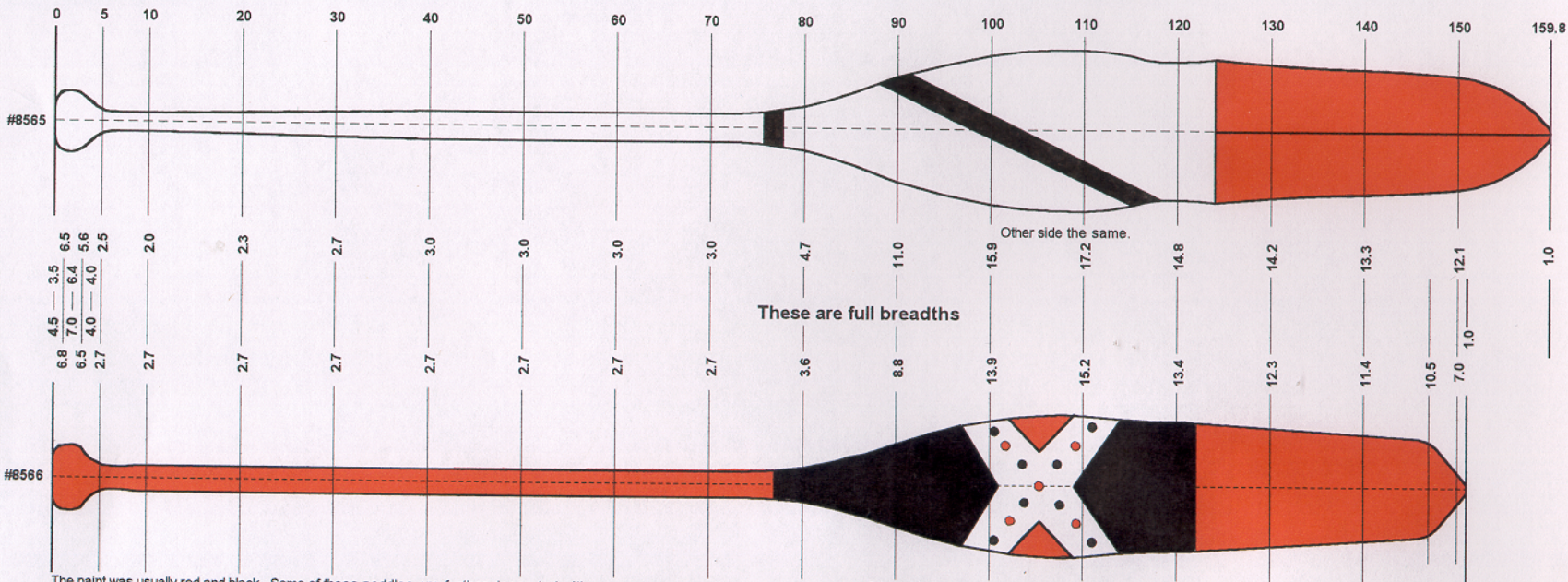


Red -

The paint was usually red and black. Some of these paddles are further decorated with gooves carved up the side starting where the blade joins the loom. The loom was elliptical in cross section, with the maximum diameter perpendicular to the plane of the blade.

Other side the same except only five dots in each diagonal starting with black on the side, & having black in the middle dot.
